CSSL Code of Conduct

The following Code of Conduct applies to all Mainland Football Clubs participating in Mainland Football activities across Canterbury, Nelson Bays, Marlborough, Mid Canterbury and West Coast including the CSSL.

Mainland Football Member Clubs and CSSL Clubs have an absolute Duty of Care to preserve the integrity of the sport of Football and are duly governed by this Code of Conduct. The CSSL/Mainland Football Code of Conduct is adopted from the NZ Football Code of Conduct which applies to all NZS members and persons participating in NZS Activities.

- Member Clubs take all reasonable steps that its members and associated persons (players, coaches, team managers, administrators, parents/guardians) refrain from any form of abuse, harassment, discrimination, victimisation towards others including but not limited to officials/referees, own team and opposition players, coaches, spectators. Similarly officials/referees will abide by the code of conduct.
- Member Clubs will take all reasonable steps that its members respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- Member Clubs will be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adherence to, standards, rules, regulations and policies.
- Member Clubs will adhere to the Covid-19 Community sport playing regulations as defined by the CSSL, Mainland Football, NZ Football and Sport NZ.
- Member Clubs understand and operate within the Constitution and playing regulations of Mainland Football.
- Member clubs will not provide comment to any media on behalf of CSSL or Mainland Football.
- Member Clubs understand the possible consequences of breaching the CSSL/Mainland Football Code of Conduct.
- Member Clubs will take all reasonable steps that the actions of its members promote the interests and uphold the integrity and positive image of the sport of Football across the Mainland Federation and CSSL.
- Member Clubs will take all reasonable steps to provide a safe playing and social environment for the conduct of CSSL and Mainland Football activity.
- Member Clubs or its members will not act in any way that may bring disrepute or disgrace to the CSSL or Mainland Football, other member clubs, Mainland Football stakeholders and/or its sponsors or commercial partners.

The CSSL expects all Clubs to understand the possible consequences of breaches and will ensure that its own members abide by the Code of Conduct which sets out to uphold the principles and values of CSSL and Mainland Football.

Any serious breaches of this Code of Conduct or persistent violations of any aspect of the Code of Conduct by any individual/s of member clubs may result in good behavior bonds or non-refundable penalties being imposed on the member club of up to \$2,000.00.

By signing the Club Contract and entering teams into the CSSL competitions, the member club agrees to abide by all parts of this Code of Conduct.
